Professional ethics

The college duly adheres to the norms of Professional ethics in the institution. Regular staff meetings are conducted to imbibe professional ethics among the staff. Discussing teaching plans, following punctuality and helping the poor and academically below average students are the basic agenda discussed in the meeting.

Before the commencement of the exams revision and guidance lectures are conducted to give knowledge to the students about the rules and regulations of the exam to be followed. 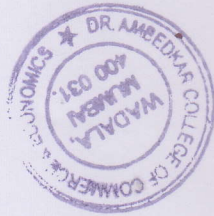
