Every year, colleges make an effort to create an inclusive environment by celebrating programs like International Yoga Day, International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking, Kargil Vijay Diwas, Independence Day Celebration, and Samvidhan Divas etc, which helps students to become responsible citizens, makes students aware about the social issues. During a pandemic, the college celebrated various programs in online mode.

Following online programs were conducted in year 2020-21.

1. International Day of Yoga is conducted on 21<sup>st</sup> June 2020

Our institution Dr. Ambedkar college of Commerce and Economics, Wadala and its employees and authorities as well as ANO and NCC Cadets celebrated International Yoga Day at their own residences with family members between 07:00 am to 08:00 am. In the academic year 2021-22, the college celebrated various programs in online as well as in offline mode.

Following online programs were conducted in year 2021-22.

1. International Day of Yoga is conducted on 21<sup>st</sup> June 2021

Our institution employees and authorities as well as ANO and NCC Cadets celebrated international Yoga Day at their own residences with family members between 07:00 am to 08:00 am. 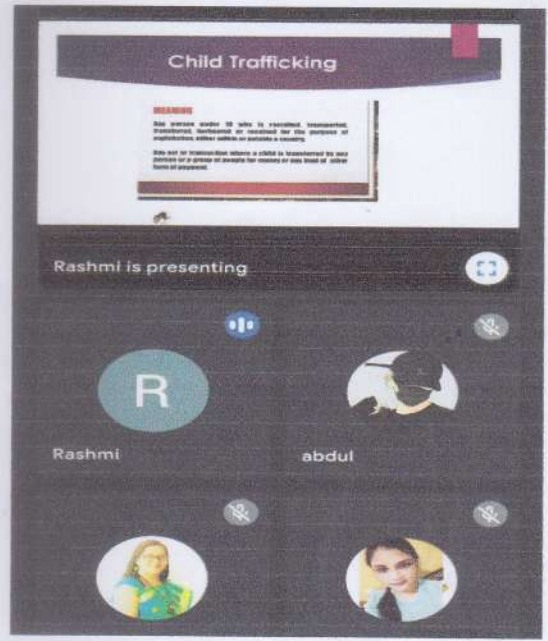
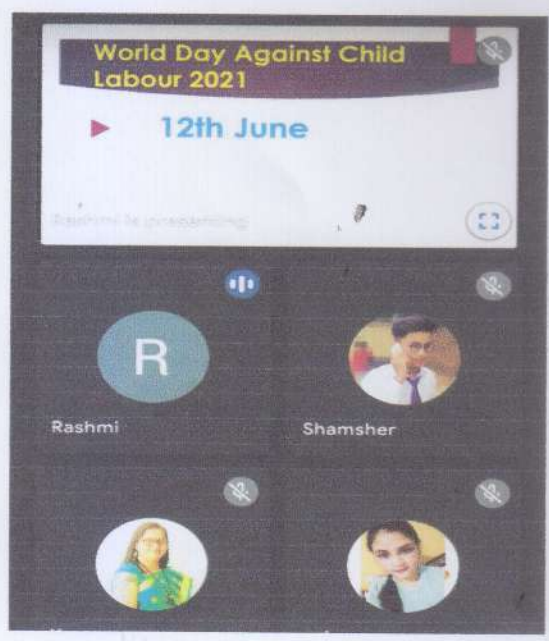




Maharashtra Day
