IQAC 2021-22 Report

Following activities have been conducted by IQAC during the academic year 2021-22.

1. National level webinar on '**World Environment Day**'. Has been conducted by the IQAC along with Environmental Studies on 5th June 2021 on the occasion of 'World Environment Day'.
2. Three days national level online workshop on '**Career opportunities in GST, Accounting & Digital marketing**' has been jointly conducted by IQAC & Career Guidance & Placement cell in association with Fin plus & Squad company. It lasted from 1st July 2021 to 3rd July 2021. Mr. Murli Bhat sir guided students on GST & Accounting on 1st and 2nd day and Mr. Maneesh Jha guided on Digital Marketing on 3rd day. 40 students were attended GST session and 46 ~~students~~ were attended Accountancy session & 40 students attended Digital Marketing session.

Following the welcome speech, Prof. Akshay Kasare gave an introductory speech and introduced the speaker. In programme students were presented as follows-

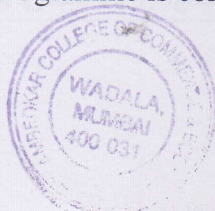

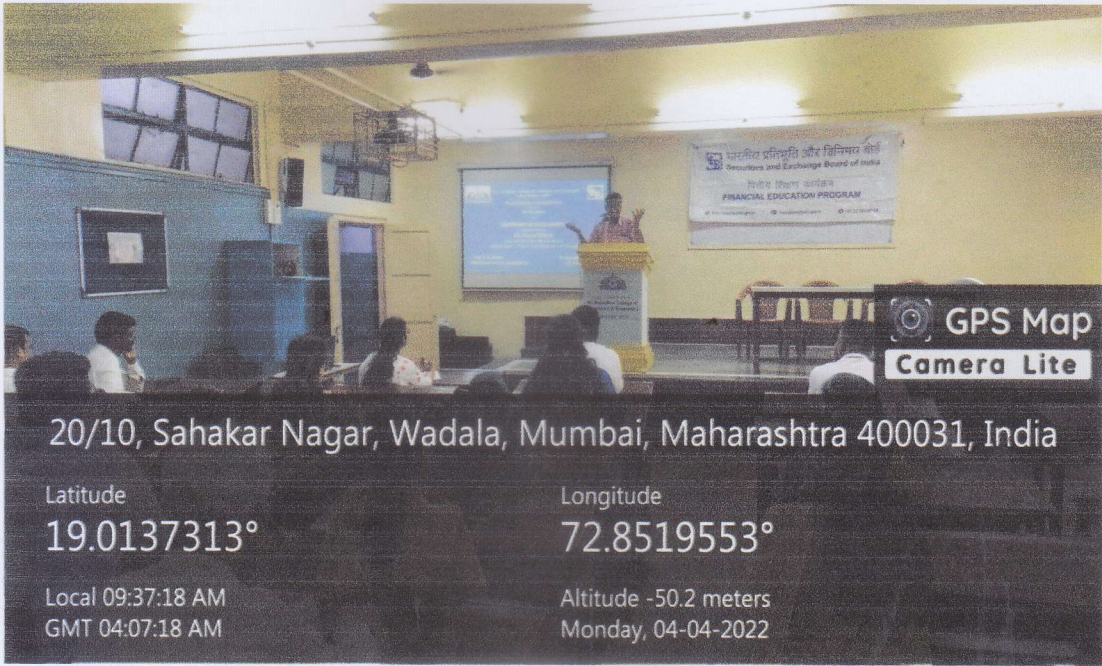
Following introductory speech, CA Deepak Vekaria gave a speech on Basics of Stock Market. He said that stock market refers to public markets that exist for issuing, buying, and selling stocks that trade on a stock exchange or over-the-counter. Stocks, also known as equities, represent fractional ownership in a company, and the stock market is a place where investors can buy and sell ownership of such investible assets. An efficiently functioning stock market is considered critical to economic development, as it gives companies the ability to quickly access capital from the public.

He also explained about Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE) and the National Stock Exchange (NSE). The BSE has been in existence since 1875.3 The NSE, on the other hand, was founded in 1992 and started trading in 1994.4 However, both exchanges follow the same trading mechanism, trading hours, and settlement process.

Deepak sir showed short film on Greediness name "Black Wholes" on YouTube. He also showed a practical scenario of stock exchange like Intra-day Trading, CNC, MIS, Derivatives, Options, and Future Trading etc.

I. 03 days National level workshop on GST, Accounting and digital Marketing:

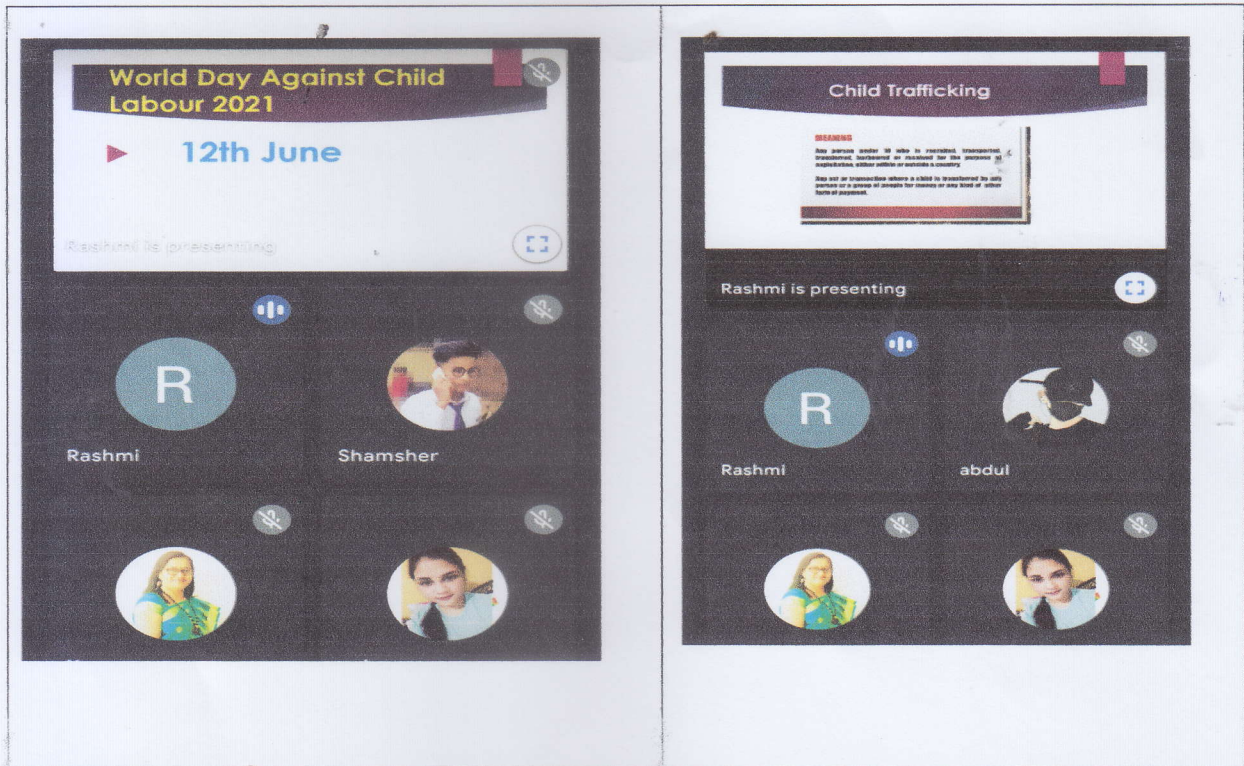


